USDA Announces Rules for Pork Checkoff Referendum

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has announced the rules for the referendum on continuation of the pork checkoff program. The nation's pork producers will have the opportunity to continue the successful 14-year-old pork checkoff, which has repositioned pork in the minds of U.S. consumers, by voting "yes" in a referendum.

According to the rules, the vote will be held September 19, 20, 21, 2000, at local USDA-Farm Service Agency (FSA) offices. Absentee voting will be August 18th to September 21st. Absentee ballots are available now.

The USDA rules restrict voting eligibility to those producers who have marketed one or more hogs from August 18, 1999, through August 17, 2000. Upon a challenge of eligibility, the USDA will require documentation of proof of sale. A complete set of rules on the referendum on continuation of the pork checkoff program are available through the local FSA offices.

The pork checkoff is designed to build demand and address issues that individual producers are not able to solve independently. The pork checkoff is producer-driven and has evolved to meet the needs of pork producers.

The checkoff funded the "Pork. The Other White Meat®" advertising campaign which has successfully repositioned pork to U.S. consumers. Also, through checkoff-funded foreign market development, the U.S. is now a net exporter of pork instead of a net importer.

Commissioner's Column

Celebrate National Farmers Market Week

Mid-summer in South Carolina---July 30th through August 5th---what a great time to celebrate National Farmers Market Week! This is the peak season for much of our fresh, locally grown produce, and farmers markets around the state are bustling with business.

The term "farmers market" means a lot of different things to a lot of people. At local farmers markets and roadside markets, growers sell their products directly to consumers. The important element is that the product only changes title once from producer directly to consumer with no middleman. Generally, the grower's representative is a family member or a person the grower employs.

While most of the local farmers markets are retail businesses---selling directly to consumers---other farmers markets that have a greater range of markets. Some are strictly wholesale. Some, like the Columbia State Farmers Market, perform both wholesale and retail functions. Local farmers may sell their products to wholesalers who then function as distributors, or they may sell directly to roadside stands, retailers, restaurants, and other institutions or to consumers. The Columbia Market also has year-round retail vendors who buy from local farmers when produce is in season and from the wholesalers the rest of the year. That's why it's so important to have both wholesalers and retailers in the same space at the Columbia Market. And, accessibility to consumers is even more important.

Wholesale farmers markets are generally urban centered markets that are redistribution facilities where operators purchase products in efficient loads and redistribute smaller loads to independent supermarkets and food service operators. For example, many of Florida's farmers markets are used as redistribution centers, not for direct sales to consumers.

Today, local farmers markets and roadside stands as well as the three State Farmers Markets in Columbia, Florence, and Greenville are critical to the success of South Carolina agriculture. They allow farmers to sell their fresh produce directly to consumers to increase their farm income.

Small and large farmers markets and roadside stands create an opportunity for citizens to meet growers and gain an appreciation of farming. Meeting and interacting with the farmers who grow the food develops a special bond of trust in the integrity and accountability of our growers. These direct markets have always been a way for non-farmers to stay in touch with our heritage and our roots.

In addition, many communities are finding it rewarding to invest in local markets as a component of economic development. Society benefits as well by being able to maintain green space created by sustaining farms on the outskirts of rural and urban areas.

Some of our local farmers markets in the state are involved in the Farmers Market Nutrition Program which provides fresh, nutritious fruits and vegetables to those who are nutritionally at-risk. There are also about a hundred facilities across the state in the Department of Agriculture's Certified Roadside Market Program. Each of these direct markets provides a place where consumers can buy fresh, locally grown produce as well as plants and flowers. Farmers markets are rejuvenating rural and urban areas and giving people a chance to talk one-on-one with farmers and vendors. People can learn about South Carolina's core values, culture, and heritage at farmers markets.

Farmers and roadside markets are major sales outlets for agricultural producers throughout South Carolina and the nation. The number of farmers markets in the U.S. has grown dramatically, increasing 56% from 1994 to 1998. Customer acceptance of farmers markets continues to rise as consumers search for fresh farm products. One survey revealed that because of farmers and roadside markets, consumers are greatly increasing their consumption of fresh fruits and vegetables, a plus for health and nutrition. In that survey, consumers also said that they go to farmers markets not only for fresh products, but also for direct contact with farmers. That's probably the only direct contact some will ever have with farmers.
