Tidbit! Jack-in-the Pulpit: This unusual shaped wildflower can be found in forests throughout SC from January to June. The common name is from the plants hooded pulpit and the spadix "Jack" found inside. The actual flowers are located inside the "Jack" at the base of the spadix. When pollinated a cluster of bright red berries form from July to August giving the plant one of its other common names "Jill-in-the Pulpit."
