In conjunction with the Lowcountry Institute and the Fripp Island Audubon Club, Hunting Island is participating in the 2010 osprey monitoring project, with the goal of using the nesting success of ospreys as an indicator of the overall health of the greater Port Royal Sound watershed. This data will be shared with the community, SCDNR, and other interested partners. So far, Hunting Island has 5 osprey nests, 2 of which are active with sitting pairs of birds. One nest has 2 chicks about to fledge. Come out to the park to view these spectacular birds of prey!
