A couple thoughts based on questions we received over and over again last time around, and my apologies if they are already contained in the document and I missed them. Let me know what you think.

1. Should we make a note somewhere that no state dollars go to the program (in accordance with the budget proviso)?
2. Should we note in the plan that there are temporal limits on the benefits coordinated by the state refugee office, and what those limits are (I believe y'all list them on the DSS page but would be good if included in the state plan)?

3. Should we note that we are hopeful only refugees that can be properly vetted for security related concerns should be resettled in SC (no mention of countries, only the vetting process)? I know this one is heavily dependent on the voluntary resettlement agencies, but it is good policy, generally, and consistent with Gov. Haley's position.

Thanks, and happy to discuss where necessary.
