**The United States is the Top Ranked Country in the world with the most Prisoners. 80 percent Blacks, 1.5 million Black Males nationwide. The Black Males over the years have received twice as much more time than any other race. Because of the Criminal Justice System and the Courts, we are in a crisis and an epidemic that's affecting our nation, cities and communities. Many inmates return home with diseases. People are carrying infected diseases that were just released from Prison.**

**In 1996 to 2009 they carried HepatitisC, 1.3 -1.4 HIV, Aids 98,000 to 145,000, Aids 39,000, Tuberculosis Latent 556,000, and Active 12,000. This is brought back into the homes and communities.**

**The Prison Systems are overpopulated and 10,000 Prisoners are released every week nationwide. This nation spend millions of dollars a year on the Criminal Justice System and building new Prisons.**

**Is this slavery? 200 years. Are we free? The blood of our children runs down the streets being shot down by the Police nationwide. My prayer is God have mercy on our race. You freed our people. 

**To Whom It May Concern:**

The United States is the top ranked country in the world with the most Prisoners. 80% Black Males are in jail, 45% Black Women in Prison, 50% Hispanic Men, 30% Hispanic Women, 40% White Men in Prison and 35% White Women. There are over two million Black Males in jail or in Prison.

This nation spends one hundred billion dollars a year in the Criminal Justice System. Private Prison Corporations make revenue. \$56 Billion. The Prisons are over populated and ten thousand Prisoners are released out of Prison every week nationwide.

We are in a crisis and epidemic that's affecting our nation, cities and communities. It cost \$100,000.00 to build a new Prison Cell. Congress has barred inmates from grants, college, correspondence courses, not eligible for Public Assistance or Public Housing. Recently higher education grants were cut off to those with Drug Records. Many inmates return home with disease. People carrying an infectious disease who were released from Prison and Jail 1996 to 2009: Hepatitis C: 1.3 -1.4 HIV/AIDS - 98,000 to 145,000 AIDS 39,000 Tuberculosis Latent 566,000 Active 12,000. These men and women are dying spiritually and naturally. For God is longsuffering, patient, loving and merciful to everyone and they deserve a second chance in life.

The Rehabilitation System in this nation is very poor in reinstating men and women back into society. We are going to build Christ Temple Rehabilitation Center/Campus. A nonprofit organization established for the purpose of helping ex-inmates strengthen their faith, equip, empower, support and restore former offenders. We are going to have a school and a Vocational Trade School, Academic Education Classes, College Courses, Computer Classes, Training, English, Math, Reading, History, Music Classes, Recreation, Psychological Counseling etc.

The cost of the School Project is \$3 million to build this Project. We will also have a Faculty that will establish a growth in jobs in our community and state. With God's help and working with the people, this Vision Will Come To Pass!

## THE LITTLE BOY

To Pastors, Family and Friends,

At six years old, I looked up into the heavens and wondered who made the world. They told me at the end of the rainbow, there is a "Pot of Gold!" A lost little boy growing up in the Inner city, I never knew this God that made the heavens and the earth and I was curious. I came from a dysfunctional family. A family of five boys, and five girls. I had a stepfather who was very mean and inconsiderate. So he made a difference in the children. He was a child abuser and a pedifier. My mother did the best she could do. So I was removed from the home and was raised from four sets of families. I felt no one loved me from six years old to nineteen years old. Because no one was there, I started stealing at the age of seven. So I went to the streets for love using drugs and running with large street gangs. I was in and out of county jail and city jail, with a lot of hatred and violence in my heart. At the age of fifteen years old I was expelled from the State of Missouri School System. Yet there was a church on the corner, and I noticed that the kids were different from me. For it seemed that there was a radiance and light about them. There were about one hundred kids on my block, large families, and I was the gang leader, and the worst of them all. What was wrong with this little boy? I needed someone to care, someone to love me, understand me, and wipe away the tears from my face. For the only education that I had was from the streets. At the age of nineteen I went to war for a country that did not respect my nationality. I was in a foxhole next to death, and knew I was dying. And I looked up to heaven in the midst of the jungle and said, if there be a God, "Help Me!" So God being merciful and longsuffering and willing for no one to die. A young white man came up to me in the jungle in Viet Nam and told me that Jesus loved me, and I received Christ in my life. And he fulfilled the love I never had.

So it's personal to me. For 40 years, I have been preaching the gospel, taking the word of God to the lost little boy in the inner city, reaching out to the youth, the children, and the adults. I need your prayers and your finances. I specifically need a van and a bus to pick up families in four areas of the inner city. Taking Christ in a dormant area. ## **Executive Summary**

The primary purpose for the establishment of Christ Temple Rehabilitation Campus is to provide affordable permanent housing and sustainable employment, Job Placement, Housing, Skill Training acquisition of training in certain trades. Education acquisition of High School Diploma/GED and College. Drug and Substance Abuse Counseling, Counseling Service for families. Reconciliation and restoration of family relationship. Jobs for ex-offender and hiring Personnel for Rehabilitation Center. We are facing Economic Crisis in America. Millions of ex-offenders. Over 10 thousand are being released a week. There are no jobs because of American Economy and because of their felony records.

Building Prison Crisis Situation cost \$100,000.00 to build a new Prison Cell. It cost \$200,000,000 over 25 years to pay interest on construction debt. And in excess of \$22,000.00 per year/per cell to operate. We are building more Prisons than Rehabilitation.

Prison Status says mid year 2003 there were 4,834 Black Prisoners per 100,000 Hispanic Male Inmates and 681 White Male. There's 80% percent Black incarcerated in America.

Rehabilitation Campus will provide Job Training, Skills, Education, Employment Opportunities and Housing. Drugs, Substance Abuse, Counseling, Private School, Religious Counseling, converting lives back in the community and society.
