Watermelon Field Day – July 12

The Clemson Extension Service, the South Carolina Department of Agriculture, and the South Carolina Watermelon Association are pleased to announce that a watermelon field day will be held at the Edisto Research and Education Center in Blackville, South Carolina, on Thursday, July 12, beginning at 4:00 PM. All watermelon producers and others interested in vegetable research projects currently being conducted at the Edisto Station are invited to attend the field day.

This event will include field tours of three research plots at the station that focus on watermelon and one plot on bell pepper. The first project concerns dye injection through drip tape that shows water displacement through the soil bed at different flow rates. The second plot is a variety trial covering twelve seedless varieties. Also, water management and fertigation for watermelons on different soil types will be viewed and discussed at the variety project site. The final melon site covers rates and formulations of Telone injected through drip tape and its effectiveness as a soil fumigant.

The final stop will feature breeding lines of bell pepper, developed at the Coastal Vegetable Research Laboratory, that show potential nematode resistance.

Dinner will be served after the tour and there will also be discussions of future plans for vegetable research projects at the Edisto Station.

Commissioner's Column

Legislation Authorizes Market Bulletin Subscription Fee

As we begin the new fiscal year, we in state government are presented with the difficult challenge of maintaining efficient and effective programs and services for you while decreasing our budgets drastically. Because of the half a billion-dollar shortfall in the state coffers, the South Carolina Department of Agriculture budget has been cut 12%. And, according to those who tend the state's pocketbook, more cuts are expected next year.

The Market Bulletin has been a valuable resource for South Carolinians since it was started in the summer of 1913 when it was first established as a bureau of marketing through which farmers could list produce they had for sale and people could send in lists of items wanted.

Because of a Proviso in the state budget bill passed by the General Assembly on June 22, 2001, I am sad to say, that we can no longer offer the Market Bulletin free to the citizens of the state and that we must begin charging \$10 for a yearly subscription. The Proviso states:

The Market Bulletin shall be mailed only to those persons who request it in writing and a record of each request shall be maintained by the Department. The Department shall biennially purge the subscription list through use of a coupon printed in the Bulletin. Provided further, that notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Department of Agriculture is authorized to charge a yearly subscription rate of \$10.00 to each person requesting the Bulletin and may charge up to \$5.00 per classified advertisement printed in the Bulletin. The funds collected pursuant to this provision shall be retained by the Department to defray the costs of publication and related incidental expenses.

In order to comply with this legislation, if you want to continue to receive the Market Bulletin, you must complete the subscription coupon at the top of this page and mail it with your \$10 subscription fee NOW. Those who have not paid for a subscription will be dropped from the mailing list in the near future. At this time, there will be no charge for ads.

Because of this new subscription policy, we can no longer accept self-addressed stamped envelopes from out-of-state. Anyone from out-of-state may now subscribe by paying the \$10 subscription fee. The Market Bulletin will continue to be available online at <http://www.scdca.state.sc.us/>.

Mail your \$10 check or money order (NO CASH), payable to the South Carolina Department of Agriculture, along with the subscription coupon correctly completed to:

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To expedite the subscription process, **DO NOT INCLUDE ADS IN THE ENVELOPE WITH YOUR SUBSCRIPTION**. Please allow 6 to 8 weeks for processing your renewal. You will know that your subscription has been renewed if you see an expiration date on your address label. That expiration date will also enable you to know when you must renew the next year. Because a fee must be paid, we can no longer accept phone subscriptions. No refunds for cancellations, etc.

For 88 years, the Market Bulletin has been a free resource for the citizens of the state to buy and sell agricultural items. Unfortunately, because of indiscriminate spending practices of others in state government, the SC Department of Agriculture and, indeed, the Market Bulletin must suffer the consequences.

Last February, I requested that you let me know whether you would be willing to pay a subscription fee. About half of you who responded said that you would be willing to pay for this publication. I hope that you will continue to support the Market Bulletin, because it would be a shame to lose another avenue for marketing SC agricultural products. When SC farmers have no way to sell their products and you have no way to buy them, they lose---and you lose, too.
