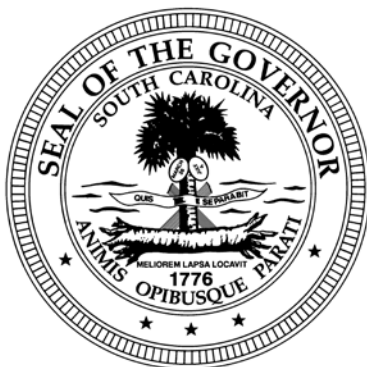
WHEREAS, dedicated Job Corps staff invest their time and talents to improve the lives of students and are essential to the Job Corps' ability to fulfill its mission; and
