#### Description/Significant Features:

Traditional vernacular I-house form, with a five bay façade; it is a single room deep, with a single story, shed-roofed extension along the rear elevation. The front elevation has a central doorway, with a transom and sidelights, which are separated slightly from the doorway. The door is flanked by two single six-over-six, double-hung, vinyl sash windows on either side. Same door/window configuration on upper story. Porch is supported by six square posts, which are divided by trim along the upper balcony floor to appear as separate columns; each column rests on a brick pier. Gabled rear ell addition; shed roofed rear porch supported by tapered columns.
