Description/Significant Features:

The area containing McCandless' burial is located on a small rise with no surface indications of a grave. It is situated just north of the road cut for SC 72 approximately 1,800 feet northeast of McCandless Rd intersection.

Alterations (include date(s), if known):

A GPR was used to located the grave in December 2018. In January of 2019 the topsoil of the grave was removed to expose the outline of the burial and to map the exact location of the burial so that road plans could be made to avoid the burial. The topsoil was then replaced back over the grave.

Historical Information:

The location of the grave was based on long-standing family tradition. There was never a marker, but at one time there were a few white stones [probably quartz rocks] clustered in the vicinity. A large cedar tree and some cactus [prickly pear?] plants were also present at the location and a wire enclosure may have been present [no trace of a wire enclosure was found during the subsequent investigation but prickly pear plants were noted near the grave location and numerous cedar roots were uncovered during backhoe testing at the location]. Both Ms. Housman and Ms. Culp thought that only a single grave was present. The grave is also recorded as archaeological site 38CS420
