WHEREAS, throughout the history of America, many men and women have bravely served in our military in order to protect our country and preserve the democratic ideals on which it was founded; and

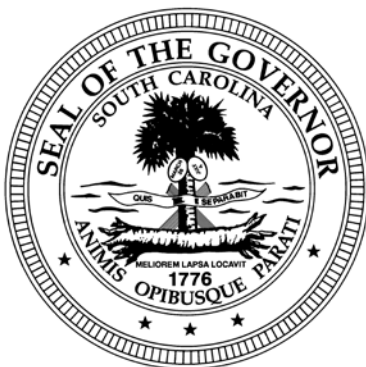
