CCAAdviser & Exam Prep Workshops

The Clemson Extension Service of Calhoun County and Clarendon County invite advisers and consultants who spend the majority of their time advising growers on agronomic practices to attend a CERTIFIED CROPADVISER (CCA) WORKSHOP on November 28-30, 2001 at the Ramada Inn in Santee, SC.

To be a CCA, advisers and consultants must meet the requirements of the American Society of Agronomy's Certified Crop Adviser Program. In order to be certified in the program, participants must earn 40 hours of continuing education (CEUs) every two years and comply with certain other criteria. With the topics to be covered at the Santee workshop, each participant should be able to acquire the 5 credits needed in each of the 4 competency areas necessary to be certified for the year.

A \$120 fee registers participants for the entire workshop and includes class material, speaker handouts, refreshment breaks, and lunch each day. For those who cannot or do not wish to attend the entire session, registration is \$50 a day.

In addition, an EXAM PREP WORKSHOP will be held on November 29-30 during the Adviser Workshop. The Exam Prep

The South Carolina
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Commissioner's Column

W.R. "Bill" Simpson puts SC in the spotlight

Bill Simpson of Manning, South Carolina, farms on land that's been in his family for almost 100 years. Building on his heritage, he and his family have developed the farm into a well-run diversified 1900-acre operation that has survived Hurricane Hugo, droughts, and other natural disasters in addition to difficult economic times.

No one can tell his story better than Bill himself. The following are excerpts from his nomination for South Carolina's Lancaster/Sunbelt Expo Farmer of the Year that will touch your heart.



Farming was a childhood dream of mine. As a kid, I plowed and planted my own crops. With advice from my father and local farmers, my meager crops prospered. They cured my tobacco and helped me market it. There were 8 children in my family, and the money I earned often went to my mother and father to help pay the bills. I also worked on local farms as I grew up, and

later I left the farm to manage a service station in Sumter. But, the smell of freshly tilled soil and the miracle of growth from a small seed always intrigued me and would ultimately bring me back---heart and soul---to farming.

I married [Daisy] in 1968, worked full time, and farmed as a hobby. Bill Jr. was born in 1969, and the thought of becoming a full-time farmer turned in my mind. In 1971, I had 30 acres of corn and gathered less than 300 bushels because of corn blight. I owed \$800 for two tractors and couldn't make the payment on either tractor. Another farmer took up the payment on one tractor, and I took another job to make the payment on the other tractor. We also ran a service station and later a family-owned convenience store to supplement our income.

The worst drought of the southeast in 1986 brought many a farmer to his knees and to the auction block. Farmers were going out of business everywhere. I took a good look at my operation and decided I needed to make changes if I wanted to survive. I started using chicken manure instead of fertilizer. I also had irrigation lines installed to pump waste from a neighboring hog farm onto our farm. I cut costs any way I could to make land and equipment payments. To help supplement our income, Bill Jr. and I started a firewood business and my wife and daughters began a cleaning business, called "Clean as a Daisy."

The biggest problem we faced since we started farming was Hurricane Hugo in 1989. Although we had droughts in 1986, 1998, 1999, and 2000, Hugo devastated our farm in one night. Our home, the sheds, equipment, fields, forests, and crops that took years to manage and develop were gone all at once. It took several years to get things back to normal. We still have trees falling around the fields from the damage done 12 years ago.

I owe my success to good management, family involvement, and, most of all, the good Lord's blessing. I have faith that when I plant my seed, the good Lord will help me see it through to the harvest.

Now, you can see why his Clarendon County Extension Agent, Russell Duncan nominated Bill Simpson, and why he was selected as South Carolina's Lancaster/Sunbelt Expo Farmer of the Year. As the South Carolina winner, Bill received a well-deserved \$1,500 cash award from Swisher International, an expense paid trip to the Sunbelt Expo, and a \$500 gift certificate from Southern States Cooperative.

Congratulations, Bill. You have made all of us in South Carolina very proud. On behalf of everyone who benefits from the fruits of your labor, we wish you well in your personal goals and in your future agricultural endeavors.

Sunbelt knows a winner when they see one. So do we. Keep up the good work, Bill, and thank you for keeping South Carolina in the spotlight for agriculture.

EQIP Sign-up

The USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and Farm Service Agency (FSA) recently announced that the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) is under a continuous sign-up and applications received by December 15, 2001, at USDA Service Centers, will be prioritized for 2002 funding. EQIP provides technical and financial assistance to eligible farmers and agricultural landowners to address soil, water and related natural resource concerns.

Approximately \$1.5 million will be provided for environmental improvement in South Carolina through priority areas and a statewide conservation concern. EQIP provides cost-sharing and incentive payments for certain conservation practices such as filter strips, nutrient management, waste management systems, waste utilization, grassed waterways, prescribed grazing, vegetative buffers, and wildlife habitat enhancement. Total cost-share and incentive payments are limited annually to \$10,000 per person and \$50,000 for the life of the contract, which can span five to 10 years. NRCS and conservation districts will ensure that county educational plans are developed in an effort to reach and inform all producers, especially underrepresented landowners.
