Hey y'all. Trying to pull out the directly Columbia/Richland related vetoes. Are there any I missed? How much did she veto for the S.C. State museum?

\$400,000 — IT-oLogy Coursepower, a computing program provided by the nonprofit organization based in Columbia aimed at growing the information technology profession.

\$380,000 — S.C. Military Museum, housed in the Adjutant General's office off Bluff Road.

?????? — S.C. State Museum

\$100,000 — Richland County Indoor Aquatic and Community Center. Haley vetoed dropping to a 1:1 match requirement for \$100,000 from the state, which was previously a 2:1 match for the aquatic center.
