It is my idea, that this is time to go to the higher hypothesis: instead of focusing on whether the confederate flag should be removed, focus should be on a Civil War healing process for ALL peoples.

As you are likely aware, there were many issues involved as the United States' Civil War ended. One is slavery. I ask you to consider a variation on the theme of just slavery and Confederate flag--to first address the need for a process of reconciliation for Confederate ancestors as well as ancestors of slaves. A process similar to the one implemented in South Africa.

Distant slave ancestors remind the world of their family history on a daily basis. They are a people still grieving, and for some, using it as an example of everything that goes wrong. Then there are the victors--the Union supporters. No grief on their part. Soldiers marched home with pay in their pockets, "reading the glory in their Nation's eyes." Fortunes were made. Not a peep out of those guys or their ancestors. A third group are the peoples of the South and their army. "Marched home in defeat...What did they find? Houses in ruins, farm devastated, stock killed, barns empty, trades destroyed, money worthless---a people without law or legal status." Ancestors of the Confederate states whose families were either actively involved or not in the rebellion, even today feel the results of this horror due to geographical location and what happened to their ancestors and their

states. They recall their destroyed culture, scourged land, destroyed homes, decimated businesses, pillaged households and businesses-For the South---state after state, Union acts focused on annihilation which continued even after Lee signed at Appomattox. At no point was there a time for grievance. To day, there is increasing black pride, but for the South, it is almost a taboo. Their dilemma was clearly stated by Georgian Henry Woodfin Grady (his monument graces downtown Atlanta, Georgia). He pondered the sad situation when he was asked to deliver an address at a New England dinner in New York (1886): "The New South". It is said that he pondered how the "South could honor its living heroes and cover with flowers the graves of its sleeping dead, and yet be loyal to the flag." It was a delicate situation he had to address. Comments above come from that address. Like 21st century Black community members, that period of time represent family recollections and ramifications that are still carried.

21st Century. Isn't it time we started a formal reconciliation process for all our people. It would be wonderful if you were the one to initiate such process now.

Who am I: neither Confederate nor Union heritage. My ancestors came from Europe and Eastern Europe early 1900's. But I have an extensive pre-Civil War, Civil War and post civil War library and an avid reader. J I am a 21st century Patriot and elder. The above issue is a disease for our people---all people. Time for reconciliation, though late in coming, must be addressed. Thank you for reading this and responding. I have time on my hands as my husband is again away for the summer studying Alaska's bears (bear-viewing-in-alaksa.info). Both my husband Dr Stephen [REDACTED] and I are hopeful that you will champion our cause. With much appreciation for your positions, Jackie [REDACTED]
