#### Description/Significant Features:

One-story, frame Ranch-style residence with a side-gabled roof and brick veneer exterior. The front elevation is four bays wide, with the western two bays located inset from the main front wall structure, beneath the main house roof; the off-center entry door and a tall, six-pane, wooden-frame casement window make up these two bays. The eastern two bays consist of six-over-six, double-hung, wooden sash windows; these smaller windows generally denote private spaces, such as bedrooms, in Ranch-style houses. Attached to the western elevation is a flat-roofed, metal carport.
