Nearly 10,000 people are released from South Carolina prisons each year. To reduce the recidivism rate, S.C. Department of Corrections (SCDC) and the S. C. Department of Employment and Workforce (DEW) created the Second Chance initiative to help returning citizens learn a skill and understand how to successfully search for a job. By helping individuals prepare for employment, they gain confidence, purpose and direction. In order to participate in many of these programs, specific requirements must be met by the participant, including a disciplinary-free record and non-violent offenses for incarceration.
