Dear Seanna,

Recall that, due to the widespread, national public interest of the underlying issues, our office chose to reduce the cost of copying records from 10 cents to 5 cents per page and to waive in its entirety the cost for staff time to search and compile records as is allowed by Section 30-4-30(b) of the South Carolian Code of Laws (a reduced charge is appropriate where waiver of the fee is determined by the agency to be in the public interest).

Previously, our office estimated that the total cost to produce your request would be \$182.10 for which a deposit of \$100.00 was required to proceed. Enclosed is a copy of the receipt and check of the \$100.00 deposit. Accordingly, the remaining balance of \$82.10 is owed to our office. 
