**WHEREAS,** Pendleton Place was founded in 1975 by the Junior League of Greenville to provide a safe home for children in foster care; and

**WHEREAS,** to better meet the needs of the community, Pendleton Place has expanded its mission over the years to include support for families in crisis as well as at-risk youth; and

**WHEREAS,** in addition to Smith House, the comprehensive residential program for teen girls who are victims of abuse or neglect, Pendleton Place offers three community-based programs; and

**WHEREAS,** from supervised visitation and safe exchange to assessment of children and families entering foster care and targeted case management for at-risk young adults and their families, Pendleton Place envisions "a community where children are safe, families are strong, and victims become whole again."

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 12, 2015, as
