**ORDER GRANTING AMERICAN MANAGED CARE, LLC
AND UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE GROUP, INC.'S MOTION TO
EXTEND TIME TO FILE AVOIDANCE ACTIONS UNDER 11 U.S.C. § 546(a)**

THIS CASE came on for hearing on January 29, 2015 (the "Hearing") on *American Managed Care, LLC and Universal Health Care Group, Inc.'s Motion to Extend Time to File Avoidance Actions Under 11 U.S.C. § 546(a)* (Doc. No. 1165) (the "Motion") filed by Soneet R. Kapila, as Chapter 11 Trustee (the "Trustee") for the bankruptcy estate of Universal Health Care Group, Inc. ("Universal"), which entity serves as the sole member of American Managed Care, LLC ("AMC"). Appearances were made as reflected on the record. For the reasons stated in open court, and having reviewed the Motion, the arguments of counsel in support of and in opposition to the Motion, the Affidavit submitted in support of the Motion (Doc. 1168), as well as the record, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, the Court finds that the Motion should be granted.

Accordingly, it is


ORDERED that:

1. The Motion is GRANTED to the extent set forth herein.

2. The Trustee's deadlines to file avoidance actions under § 546(a) for both the Universal and AMC bankruptcy estates are extended until August 31, 2015, except as to claims against Warburg Pincus, LLC.

3. The objections of Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. and Wells Fargo Securities, LLC (collectively, "Wells Fargo"), as raised at the Hearing, are hereby overruled.
