## Carolina Classic Boer Goat Association Show Scheduled

The South Carolina Chapter of the International Boer Goat Association (SC IBGA) has scheduled their first annual Carolina Classic Boer Goat Show at the Newberry Fairgrounds on Saturday, June 22, 2002 in Newberry, SC.

The Boer goat was imported into the United States in the early 1990s. The breed was developed to provide a higher quality carcass and is a highly sought after food source for our fast growing ethnic population. A mature buck can achieve a weight of 300 pounds. Mature does can reach 200 pounds.

The statewide show will be nationally sanctioned and open to entrants from the US and Canada. All Boer Goat registries including the American Boer Goat Association, International Boer Goat Association and the Canadian Boer Goat Association will be accepted. Deadline for entering goats in the show is June 10, 2002.

## LEGAL NOTICE ON REFERENDUM FOR CONTINUANCE OF THE MARKETING ORDER FOR SOUTH CAROLINA TOBACCO

According to the rules governing continuance of marketing orders under provisions of the Agricultural Commodities Marketing Act, notice is given that the Agriculture Commission of South Carolina will conduct a referendum by mail among affected producers to determine continuance of the Tobacco Marketing Order during the period May 1-15, 2002.

"XV. CONTINUANCE: Prior to the completion of each five (5) calendar years from the effective date of their Order, the Commission shall resubmit this Order to a referendum of affected producers according to the requirements of initial assent pursuant to Section 14 of the Act. In the event that the required assent is not given by the affected producers, this Order shall be declared to be terminated."

## Commissioner's Column

### Eastern Produce Council Essential Market for South Carolina Produce

For the past 31 years, South Carolina has hosted the annual meeting of the Eastern Produce Council which represents the major wholesale and retail buying community in the greater New York, New Jersey, and Philadelphia areas. Throughout the years the event has proven to be a very successful effort in promoting the movement of the state's products to this large consumer population of 15 to 18 million people.

Last year, I invited my friend and fellow agriculture advocate to attend this event---Senator Bob Waldrep (District 3, Anderson Co.), Chairman of the Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee. He was so impressed with the event last year that I invited him this year to lead our delegation from South Carolina to host the 31st consecutive Eastern Produce Council meeting. The event, organized by Wayne Mack, Director of Marketing, and Martin Eubanks, Senior Marketing Specialist, of the SC Department of Agriculture, was held on Tuesday, April 30, 2002, at the Crown Plaza in Secaucus, New Jersey.

People ask why we host this event. The answer is, like any other business, marketing is a major part of successful agricultural trade. Today, the competition is greater than ever in our history. South Carolina's fruit and vegetable marketers must compete with other states and other nations for markets. Peaches, watermelons, and tomatoes don't wait. They must be shipped when the window of opportunity is open. That is why our marketing staff has worked so diligently throughout the years to develop good working relationships with our markets in the northeast.

Consumers demand fresh, high quality food that tastes as good as it looks, and SC produce offers the best of both---good looks and great taste! SC Quality is recognized by consumers everywhere, and our growers can harvest today and get it to market tomorrow. That's fast! They can also grow fresh produce year round because of our mild climate and new technology. That's consistent! But, even though we have a consistent supply of fresh, quality produce, we must have a ready market for when the time is right.

South Carolina needs agribusiness partners like the members of the Eastern Produce Council to continue to be successful in the business of agriculture. That's why I highly advocate this partnership between the North and the South---South Carolina, that is.

About 100 growers, shippers, brokers, and fresh produce handlers attended this year's Eastern Produce Council meeting. Because of this event South Carolina has developed lasting relationships with buyers as well as an opportunity for networking with potential customers.

The South Carolina delegation included: peach grower and former Chairman of the Ag Commission of South Carolina Larry Yonce of Johnston; watermelon grower and President of the SC Watermelon Association Billy Jenkins of Jefferson; and vegetable grower and President of the newly formed SC Fruit, Vegetable, and Specialty Crop Association Chris Rawl of Lexington.

Senator Waldrep believes in what we are doing for our produce industry and says that this event is one of the best opportunities the state has to promote South Carolina grown fruits and vegetables in this major market of 15 to 18 million people. Senator Waldrep knows that agriculture in South Carolina is big business, and that the fruit and vegetable industry is a large part of that business. But, the loss of a market like the buyers in the Eastern Produce Council could strike a severe blow to the people in the communities served by the state's produce industry.

Senator Waldrep said, "As we have seen in other parts of the country and the world, when agriculture fails, the economies fail, too. I, for one, encourage the SC Department of Agriculture to continue this effort to keep farm families and their communities in business. In addition, I pledge my support and will continue to urge my fellow citizens and legislators to support this and other marketing efforts to keep agriculture strong and viable in the state."

### South Small Flock Certification Program

A Small Flock Certification Program will be held May 24 and May 25, 2002 at Clemson University. The program will begin on Friday, May 24th at 1:30 pm with NPIP certification classes, followed by a necropsy laboratory and disease and parasites of poultry.

On Saturday, the program is scheduled to begin at 8:30 am and end at 4 pm. Topics that day will include Nutrition, Biosecurity, Rodent Control, Farm Management Plan and Genetics.

Clemson University Extension Service and the SC Department of Agriculture have developed the Small Flock Certification Program, designed to bring small poultry flocks into compliance with the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP). Since the commercial poultry industry in South Carolina is valued at \$1.5 billion, preventing disease infestations between small and/or commercial flocks is essential. In addition, following the NPIP provides small flock owners with better quality poultry. The criteria for becoming certified in the program requires that each flock be NPIP Certified and the flock owner be a certified tester. NPIP workshops will be offered twice a year.
