Chairman John "Robbie" Robertson, Irmo, called the meeting of the South Carolina Athletic Commission to order at 10:00 A.M., on Monday, May 22, 2000, with a quorum present at the Department of Labor, Licensing & Regulation, room 104-01, 110 Centerview Drive, Columbia, South Carolina.
