SUBJECT: Appointment of Interim Executive Director, Tri-County Community Mental Health Center

Effective March 2, 2018, R. Michael Truluck, will assume the role of Interim Executive Director of the Tri-County Community Mental Health Center.

He is currently the Center's Chief of Clinical Services, CAF Coordinator, liaison to DMH hospitals, and emergency services coordinator.
