Party Nominee May Not Take Oath Today

Mumbai/New Delhi: BJP's estranged ally Shiv Sena has agreed to be part of the expansion of the Modi ministry, but is insisting on the simultaneous resolution of the Maharashtra tangle as a pre-condition.

Sources said Uddhav Thackeray has recommended Anil Desai for inclusion in the Modi government when it is expanded on Sunday afternoon. But there are doubts whether Sena's Rajya Sabha member will take oath along with 20 others as new members of Modi's government because of BJP's refusal to concede Sena's demand for posts of deputy chief minister and assembly Speaker in Maharashtra.

Anant Geete, the Sena's sole representative so far in the Cabinet, was scheduled to meet the PM but confirmed that the meeting did not take place, a sign that tension between the two parties appears to be rising.

And then, the 7am Mumbai-London flight left after 4.30pm — the time it was supposed to reach Heathrow.
