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## **Funding Available to Help Community Providers Use Health Information Technology**

### **Up to 10 Cooperative Agreements Available**

The Office of the National Coordinator recently released a Funding Opportunity Announcement for the Community Interoperability and Health Information Exchange Cooperative Agreement Program. This program makes available a total of \$1 million for up to 10 awardees to expand resources for doctors, patients and communities to work together to unlock health information data. Funding is intended to help communities create opportunities for long-term services and supports and behavioral health providers who may not currently participate in the collection and exchange of health information.

Entities eligible to apply include domestic non-profit organizations, state or local governments, agencies or groups in a designated community.

The deadline for applications is **June 15, 2015**.
