Description/Significant Features:

East of the house is a small, single story, side-gabled frame residence; it is of frame construction and has a large, exterior, stone chimney on its western elevation; the chimney is flanked by a single six-over-six, double-hung, wooden sash window on either side. The north and south elevations have shed-roofed porches; the southern porch appears to be the front elevation and has been partially enclosed, while the northern porch has been fully enclosed. The house rests on a pier foundation that is comprised of both stone and concrete block.
