**A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

EXPRESSING THE GRATITUDE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO THE HONORABLE JOSEPH OSCAR ROGERS, JR., OF CLARENDON COUNTY FOR HIS DEDICATED SERVICE AS A MEMBER OF THE STATE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION, COMMENDING HIM FOR HIS DISTINGUISHED CAREER AS A PUBLIC SERVANT, CONFERRING UPON HIM THE TITLE OF COMMISSIONER EMERITUS OF THE STATE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION, AND REQUESTING THE STATE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION OF THIS STATE TO DRAW UPON HIS VAST KNOWLEDGE ON A REGULAR BASIS.

WHEREAS, Joseph Oscar Rogers, Jr., of Clarendon County, a distinguished lawyer and resident of Manning, has served the State of South Carolina outstandingly as a member of the State Commission on Higher Education; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rogers is a former member of the South Carolina House of Representatives from Clarendon County, a World War II veteran, and a graduate of the University of South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, he was an influential member of the Committee on Ways and Means during his service in the House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, he won his party's nomination for Governor of South Carolina in 1966 and later was appointed by the President of the United States as the United States Attorney for South Carolina, a position in which he served admirably; and

WHEREAS, on July 26, 1978, he was appointed as a member of the State Commission on Higher Education by Governor James E. Edwards and has served nearly five years in that capacity during an era

of unparalleled growth and development of the State's institutions of higher education; and

**WHEREAS**, his record as a member of the State Commission on Higher Education has been distinguished; and

**WHEREAS**, while he was a member of the General Assembly, he was a leader in the early industrial development of the Pee Dee area of South Carolina and the author of many significant legislative acts which will affect the lives of citizens of South Carolina for generations to come; and

**WHEREAS**, he has always maintained a special interest in improving the state's educational system; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Assembly feels that it is fitting and proper to confer on Joseph Oscar Rogers, Jr., the title of Commissioner Emeritus of the State Commission on Higher Education and requests the State Commission on Higher Education and the institutions of higher education of this State to draw upon his vast knowledge on a regular basis, as the members of the General Assembly do on matters pertaining to government, business, and education.

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

**THAT** the members of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, by this resolution, express their gratitude to the Honorable Joseph Oscar Rogers, Jr., of Clarendon County for his dedicated service as a member of the State Commission on Higher Education, commend him for his distinguished career as a public servant, confer upon him the

title of Commissioner Emeritus of the State Commission on Higher Education, and request the State Commission on Higher Education and the institutions of higher education of this State to draw upon his vast knowledge on a regular basis.




