Our office received your Freedom of Information Act request for "all records and correspondence related to the S.C. House Ethics Committee and the committee's investigation of Gov. Nikki Haley."

I understand you wish to narrow your request to include only communications regarding the ethics investigation. The majority of communications will be exempt pursuant to South Carolina Code Section 30-4-40(a)(7) (correspondence or work product of legal counsel).

All non-exempt communications that are not currently available in the public domain are limited to press-related communications with Mr. Rob Godfrey. If you wish to receive the press-related correspondence, let us know and we will estimate the cost of production.
