

Summary of Interim Facilities Projects

The Commission on Higher Education considers interim permanent improvement projects submitted by the institutions on a quarterly basis. Projects submitted to CHE by the technical colleges must have been approved by the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education prior to submission to CHE.

All projects submitted by the institutions are reviewed by staff and are presented to the Committee on Finance and Facilities with recommendations. The Committee considers the projects and presents its recommendations to the Commission. Once the Commission has acted on these projects, the projects will be submitted to the Joint Bond Review Committee of the Legislature and to the State Budget and Control Board for additional approvals.

Five institutions submitted 10 interim projects for consideration. These consist of four budget increases totaling \$4,162,225, five requests to establish projects totaling \$9,882,385, and one request to purchase a building for \$9,000,000. The total dollar amount of the interim projects submitted is \$22,044,910. In addition, one lease request was submitted for consideration.
