The US Department of Treasury announced this week that taxpayers do not have to file amended returns if they already filed their 2014 tax returns with an incorrect 1095-A form. The IRS said it will not pursue any additional taxes owed due to the mistake of reporting 2015 values in Column B of the form (Second Lowest Cost Silver Plan or SLCSP) instead of 2014 values.

If taxpayers determine that they will receive a higher Premium Tax Credit (PTC) with the corrected form, then they certainly can, and should, amend their return. **Learn More**

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
