No apology necessary and I'd be glad to speak with you via phone.

The Class of 1969 usually sponsors the 11:00 symposium timeslot in which Governor Haley will speak. For past symposiums, we have worked with agencies such as the Washington Speakers Bureau—those speakers are for fee. The Class of 1969 funds the speech (if a fee is required) and we ensure the Class is recognized in the program and the President's introduction.

The Class of 1969's donor support qualifies them to sponsor this timeslot each year, and the Class hopes to fund this event well into the future through an endowment. So no one determined the class, their past and continued support of the symposium is the qualification. Governor Haley will not need to acknowledge the Class in her remarks. We want to ensure the Governor's office is aware of this and ensure we don't violate protocol.

Governor Haley will speak on March 17<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 AM. Governor Haley will speak on 17 March at 11:15 AM. Please let us know the time Governor Haley is scheduled to arrive on campus. We usually have an office call with the President in his office and, depending on the weather, they walk to McAlister Field House. In order to allow enough time for this to occur, we request that Governor Haley arrive on campus at 10:15 AM.

Where will the event take place? Do you have an address? The event will take place in McAlister Field House, located on The Citadel campus. The address is: 171 Moultrie Street. The link to our virtual campus is: <http://www.citadel.edu/virtualtour/>. McAlister Field House is #21.

How will the location be set-up? Stage? Podium? Microphone? Rows of chairs? We will not have a stage. I have attached pictures of the set-up (please note: distinguished guests will be seated on the floor and cadets/other students will be seated in the bleachers/chairbacks.) We will have a microphone on the podium. Will Governor Haley also like to use a lapel microphone? Also, please let me know if Governor Haley will have a PowerPoint presentation.

What would you like for Governor Haley's remarks to focus on? Leadership is the overall theme. With that in mind, we have several suggestions: Courageous leadership during difficult times, Charleston Strong, AME Shooting, Response to the flood, the Governor's observations of the AME victims and how they model forgiveness.

Will this event be opened to the press? Yes, unless you tell us that it cannot be open to the public.

Who will introduce the Governor? Lieutenant General John W. Rosa, USAF, Retired, President, The Citadel

The Governor plans to speak for 12-15 minutes. Is this ok? Yes.

Is Q&A appropriate? If so, the Governor can do Q&A for 5-7 minutes. We plan to have Q&A after the Governor's speech which will be moderated by our Regimental Commander, Cadet Colonel Jimmy Urban.

How many attendees do you expect and what is their background? (Students? Faculty?) 2,300 attending which includes members of the Corps of Cadets, Visiting Student Delegates from other colleges/universities, The Citadel faculty, staff, senior leadership and members of the Board of Visitors, and special guests.

To familiarize you with the Greater Issues address—Once all of the guests are seated, the cadet adjutant calls “All Rise”. Everyone in the field house will stand as Governor Haley, Lieutenant General Rosa, and Cadet Colonel Jimmy Urban enter. General Rosa will go to the podium while Governor Haley and Cadet Colonel Urban go to their seats. General Rosa will introduce Governor Haley, and she will walk to the podium, shake General Rosa’s hand and deliver her address.

At the conclusion of the address, we will hold a Q&A moderated by Cadet Urban. After the Q&A, Cadet Urban will present Governor Haley with a framed print of Padgett-Thomas Barracks.

After the Greater Issues address, Governor Haley is invited to join General Rosa in Coward Hall for the Corps Day Birthday Luncheon. If she attends, she will sit at the head table with General Rosa and Cadet Urban. Please let me know if Governor Haley will be able to stay for lunch.

We are working on the script for this event and will email it to you once it is finalized.
