

**WIL LOU GRAY OPPORTUNITY SCHOOL  
BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
February 23, 1993**

The Board of Trustees convened for a special called meeting at 5:15 p.m. on February 23, 1993, in the Wil Lou Gray Opportunity School Research and Training Center. Trustees in attendance were: Mr. Frank Hart, Dr. Louise Scott, Mrs. Olive Wilson, Mrs. Elizabeth Thrailkill, Mrs. Mickey Lindler, Mrs. Betty Henderson, Mrs. Mary Williams, Mr. Vince Rhodes and Dr. Marvin Efron. Mr. Hart called the meeting to order. He stated for the record that the notice of the meeting was provided to the public in conformance with the requirements of the S. C. Freedom of Information Act, Section 30-4-80(d) of the S. C. Code of Laws, 1976 as amended.

A motion was made by Dr. Efron to move into executive session to discuss a legal matter and the effects of restructuring on personnel. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Wilson. The motion was passed.

Number 2: The Opportunity School would be grouped with South Carolina Vocational Rehabilitation. Dr. Norwood was directed to prepare a written statement to that effect with rationale for each priority.

A motion was made by Mrs. Lindler to proceed as per recommendations of the attorney regarding legal action on teacher pay. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Wilson. The motion was passed.

A motion was made by Dr. Efron to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Wilson. The motion was passed.
