Description/Significant Features:

The historic core of the single-story frame Period Cottage stands three bays wide and is clad in asbestos shingles. A side-gabled roof on which sets two front-gabled dormers caps the building. Two chimneys, one interior brick chimney projecting through the front slope of the building's roof, and the second being an exterior gable end stone chimney are found on the building. A centrally placed projecting front gable block holds the building's door which is topped with a segmented fanlight and appears to be original. The building additionally retains its original six-over-six sash. Multiple additions, including a garage and screened in porch, have been made to the building extending its footprint.
