Description/Significant Features:

The single story frame Minimal Traditional residence is three bays wide and two piles deep. A broken side-gabled roof tops the building, which is clad in asbestos shingles. An engaged two bay porch embraces the facades eastern two bays and is supported by wooden columns. The building's primary entrance rests beneath the porch and holds what appears to be an early door. Some of the building's windows appear to be original and some replacement. A brick chimney stack is seen rising from the building's northern roof slope.
