



MOTION TO EXTRADITE UNDER THE INTERSTATE AGREEMENT





THAT GUN WAS IN THE TRUCK. I'M ALSO BEING CHARGED AGAIN FOR THE TRUCK.


I WANT YOU TO KNOW I WAS 100% HONEST WITH YOU AND I HOPE
