**WHEREAS,** archaeological sites are unique and irreplaceable remains that represent at least 14,000 years of occupation in South Carolina; and

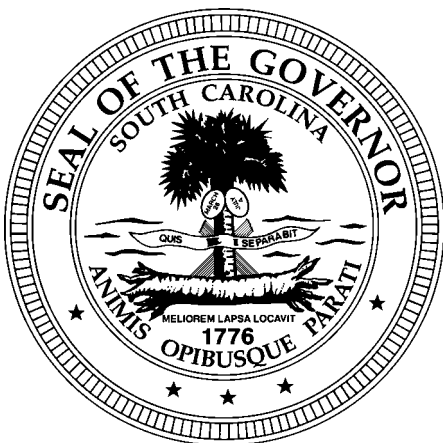
**WHEREAS,** protection and preservation of these sites and artifacts provide educational, scientific, and economic benefits for all citizens of the Palmetto State; and
