It was a pleasure meeting you the other day. At our meeting, the Governor requested that I provide you information with your legislators and delegation so that you knew which DOT Commissioner represented your area.

First, based on your address, your local legislators are as follows:

- Your South Carolina State Senator is SC Senate District 38 - Sean Bennett.
- Your South Carolina State Representative is SC House District 98 - Chris Murphy.

Second, as mentioned in our meeting, the Department of Transportation is governed by the South Carolina Transportation Commission. The Commission is comprised of eight members, one of whom the Governor appoints and seven of whom are elected by the legislative delegations. The legislative delegation is comprised of all of the local legislators within that congressional district. In other words, the members of the General Assembly (senators and house members) that represent voters in that congressional district. Dorchester County is split into two congressional districts. Based on your address, your congressional delegation is below. As you can see, your local legislators are listed within the delegation.
