COLUMBIA, S.C. – Governor Nikki Haley today announced the appointment of Mark Keel to be the next Director of the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) during an afternoon press conference. Mr. Keel currently serves as Director of the South Carolina Department of Public Safety (DPS), a post he has held since 2008.

Mr. Keel served at SLED for almost 29 years, including six months as Interim Director from December 2007 – April 2008, before taking over as DPS Director.
