

Conference on Development of Cooperatives
in the Southeastern United States

The South Carolina State University (SCSU) Center for Rural Cooperative Business Development is leading a multi-institutional effort to organize a conference on "Development of Cooperatives in the Southeastern United States." The conference will be held on October 29-30, 2001, at the White Oak Conference Center in Winnsboro, SC, and is being conducted as an activity for National Cooperative Month.

The purpose of the conference is to increase awareness among underrepresented rural communities about the benefits of membership in cooperatives. The program has been designed to enhance collaboration among farm and non-farm cooperatives in the southeastern United States. This conference should be of interest to members of all rural communities, members and staff of non-farm communities, state and federal government representatives, policy makers, and others.

Renowned national and regional leaders of cooperatives are being invited to share their perspectives on "Cooperatives in 2020" and "Steps in Developing a Cooperative." Four concurrent sessions will address "Marketing by Small Farmers," "Alternative Farming," "Deregulation," and "Small Business Development." In addition, a six-member panel from farm and non-farm cooperatives in the southeastern region is being invited to present "Success Stories" and help identify the essential ingredients for their success. Federal and state agencies, cooperatives and others interested in cooperatives are invited to share information through exhibits at no cost. The program is being finalized and should be available for dissemination in early September.

Pre-registration is encouraged. Lodging will be provided for a limited number of small farmers who pre-register at least two weeks before the conference. The registration fee of \$10.00 includes all refreshments, two lunches and dinner on the first night. The fee should be included with the registration form.

Commissioner's Column

Freedom to Farm

Freedom to Farm has taken on a new meaning since September 11th. To most of us involved in agriculture, Freedom to Farm referred to 1996 legislation that concerned free competition. With the recent events that have taken place, Freedom to Farm is literally the right and privilege to pursue our chosen profession in farming.

Freedom to Farm was federal legislation designed to allow producers and farmers to better compete in the free enterprise system by phasing out government price supports. The objective was to place agriculture in a market-based rather than a program-based system. However, Freedom to Farm did not have an adequate safety net for producers and farmers to deal with low commodity prices and weather-related disasters. Freedom to Farm expires in 2002, and Congress is currently working on developing a new farm bill.

Ann Veneman, USDA Secretary, recently presented a review of food and agriculture policy with a view toward identifying critical needs for the new century. The report suggested that past farm policies simply cannot meet the current needs of a modern, rapidly expanding food and agricultural system. The report also offered a set of principles to guide policy development for trade, a farm safety net, system infrastructure, conservation and environment, rural communities, nutrition and food assistance, and program delivery. The National Association of State Departments of Agriculture (NASDA), an organization of commissioners, secretaries, and directors from each of the 50 states and the four trust territories of which I am a member, has been working for over a year on recommendations for a new policy. We encourage Congress to use those recommendations to formulate that new policy.

On the other hand, Freedom to Farm has a different meaning. It means that farmers and their families have all the inalienable rights and privileges set forth by our Constitution. But with concern about terrorism within the United States, everyone, farmer and non-farmer, may need to allow a certain loss of freedom to protect our families and us and to keep our state and nation secure. The trickle-down effect will touch everyone---farmers and producers included.

To maintain that protection, farmers and producers may be asked to make some short- and long-term changes in the way they operate. For instance, the recent grounding of aerial applicators at a critical time in the growth cycle was a concern for some of our crops here in South Carolina. While it was a threat to the livelihood of our farmers, the alternative was a threat to our very lives.

The threat of terrorism remains a concern for all of us. We must unite against these radicals---from special interest extremists---most notably within the animal rights and environmental movements who conduct acts of violence to further their causes---to international terrorists who perform unspeakable acts of violence to further their causes. The only way to defeat terrorism is to stop it, eliminate it, and destroy it where it grows.

We have seen long lines of discontented people in other countries---people with no freedom---people dying from terrorist bombs while waiting in line for a loaf of bread. We have now seen it on our own homeland.

The freedoms we enjoy often come at a price. In the days to come, we will all be touched by heightened security in some way or another. But, we must remember that our basic freedoms are not being revoked--they are being protected. We are resolved. We are united. And, we will rise to defend all that we cherish . . . and that includes the freedom to continue to provide the raw products for food, shelter, and clothing for the people of this state, nation, and, indeed, the world.

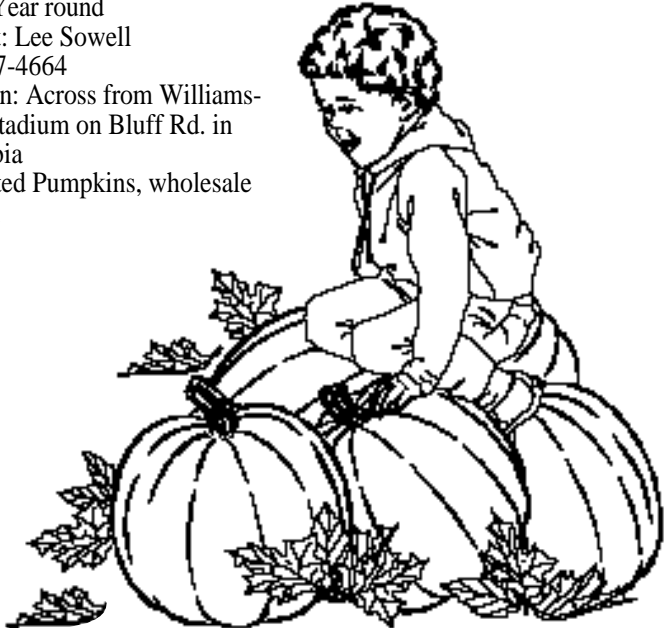
