WHEREAS, as important members of the health care team, Certified Nursing Assistants provide basic nursing and personal care to help long term care residents perform daily tasks; and

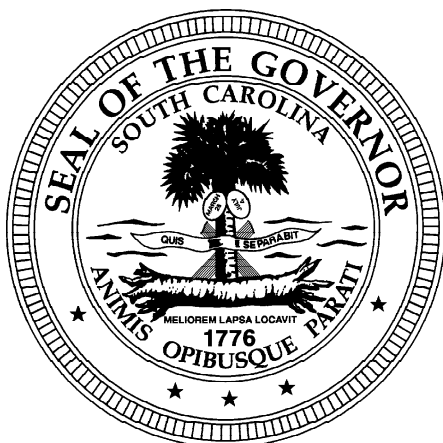
WHEREAS, Certified Nursing Assistants recognize the diversity of residents' health care needs and strive to respect each patient's dignity and independence; and
