



This Plan Exhibits the shape and form of a Piece or Parcel of Land situated on Melasses Creek at Habersham Point in the Parish of Christ Church the Purchase by Commission appointed by an Act of Assembly Passed the 7th of April 1770 for a Powder Magazine from Clement Lempriere on the 17th of April 1771 for 100 acres But which is found to contain the land only Nine Acres and twenty five Hundredths (viz) 9 Acres 81 Hundredths of High land & 1 Acre 74th of Marsh Being Parts of an Tract of 196 Acres conveyed unto the said Clement Lempriere by Alexander Chisholm or by his Heirs dated the 6th October 1761 which was originally granted by the Lords Proprietors unto Francis Lempriere in 100 Acres but one for 90 Acres on the 20th March 1760 and the other for 10 Acres on the 1st December 1760 — The said such Bounds and matters as Expresses and represented above From a Survey taken at the request of His Hon^{or} the Lieutenant Governor on the 15th May 1760
