WHEREAS, the Montessori program, a system for the education of children from birth through the age of eighteen, uses materials, techniques and observations that support students' natural development, encourage their learning, independence and self-confidence, and advance the principles of peace through responsible citizenship; and

WHEREAS, the Montessori Method includes developmental teaching, one-to-one lessons and the promotion of respect among the children and peace to humankind.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim February 28 - March 4, 2011, as

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to recognize the valuable contributions made by Montessori schools to students in the Palmetto State.
