WHEREAS, each year, over 324,000 individuals receive patient-focused, coordinated health care services, including preventative and primary medical and dental care, case management and behavioral services, prenatal and postnatal care, and help with fitness and healthier eating, from community-based facilities across the Palmetto State; and

WHEREAS, community health centers deliver high-quality, cost-effective, and affordable health care to medically underserved people and localities; and

WHEREAS, in addition to contributing to improved health in our communities, these facilities help lower the cost of health care by reducing inappropriate emergency room and hospital utilization.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim August 11 - 17, 2013, as
