Commissioner’s Column

SC Agriculture---Year in Review

The year 2000 was the beginning of a new era---a time of promises and fresh starts for all people in South Carolina. The year 2001 is another new dawning---the official beginning of the new millennium.

Farmers looked to the year 2000---hoping for enough moisture to end the long drought that has plagued the state for the past three years and hoping for more profitable yields and lower production costs. As the new year begins, farmers again find themselves hoping and waiting---hoping and waiting---for the right weather at the right time in the right places and the relief they need to move forward in their businesses.

The last few years have been like riding a roller coaster for farmers, agriculturally and emotionally. At the beginning of December, moisture for the Midlands and the southern part of the state were near normal while the Pee Dee area and the northeastern part of the state were unusually moist. At the same time, the Upstate remained in a moderate drought. In 1961, a record of 40 days without rainfall was set, and on November 4, 2000, we tied that record.

Even though much of the state remains in a drought status, SC crops have fared well, for the most part. The state’s yields for corn, cotton, peanuts, soybeans and tobacco are up from last year, according to the SC Agricultural Statistics Service, but don’t let these figures fool you. Since SC had a very dry, very low yield for most crops in 1999, the improvements this year can be deceptive.

Cotton production is expected to total 380,000 bales, up 99,000 bales from last year. In addition, only one errant boll weevil was found in the state, due, in part, for SC’s very successful Boll Weevil Eradication Program. Because of the program, only cotton in the area where the boll weevil is discovered is sprayed for the pest, saving production costs and protecting the environment. Even though the state is virtually rid of the boll weevil, the program must remain in place because if an infestation should occur, it would take about 2 1/2 years to contain and eliminate the outbreak. That’s why homeowners are not permitted to grow ornamental cotton without a permit. One boll weevil could start an epidemic the likes of which we never want to see again.

In addition to cotton, other crops have fared better this year than in 1999. When all the totals are counted, corn production is expected to total 19.6 million bushels, up 350,000 bushels from last year's production. But, in 1999, corn was all but wiped out because of the drought. Assuming normal weather conditions, soybean production is expected to be up 20% from 1999. Tobacco yields were up from last year, even though tobacco harvested acreage was down 5,000 acres. Quotas have been cut so much in the past three years that growers are earning profit on 53.1% less acreage. That’s like losing 53.1% of your salary in three years. Not many of us could survive that! In addition, tobacco is now being sold in bales, for the most part, instead of in piles on the warehouse floors and manufacturers are beginning to contract with growers to produce flue-cured tobacco. The tobacco industry has changed forever.

Because of the drought, many livestock producers had to begin feeding hay early. Since SC is a hay deficit state (meaning that we don’t produce quite enough hay to meet our own needs), our producers must import hay from other states. Hopefully, we will receive some precipitation this winter in whatever form we can get it to help replenish our water supply. Then, come spring, our producers will be able to provide forage and hay, once again, for their livestock.

So, while 2000 may have been good for some, it was not so good for others. Some are in good shape. Some are hanging on for another year. Some are considering selling their farms, because it is becoming more profitable for some to sell their land than it is to farm it. We must find ways to deal with the dilemma of keeping green space accessible for farming and recreation without compromising landowners’ rights while providing areas for development. This will continue to be a major focus in the coming months, and there will be many opinions voiced about how local and statewide growth should be handled.

No matter what the problems of the past, the members of our agricultural family look to the future with a renewed sense of hope and dedication to making life a little better for themselves and for those around them. All of us in SC have reasons to celebrate, in part, because of our state’s agricultural family and their mission beyond that of earning a living. On behalf of all who reap the benefits of their hard work, I am deeply grateful.

And to all the people of South Carolina, I wish you the happiest of holidays and a successful, prosperous New Year!
