Good Morning,

The deadline to complete permanent work as a result of the 2015 Severe Storms and Flooding (FEMA-4241-DR-SC) is April 4, 2017. This deadline applies to the completion of the permanent work itself, not the completion of project worksheets and payment for those projects. If permanent work is complete, no further action is required; however, if you still have work to be completed, please be mindful of the deadline and the process outlined below for requesting an extension.

Extensions may be submitted via written request to Kim Stenson, Governor's Authorized Representative, or via SCRecoveryGrants using the instructions provided at the following link: <https://screcoverygrants.org/app/#help/userguide?t=projects--projectextension>

If a time extension is needed, please include the project worksheet number, the dates and provisions of any previous extensions granted for the particular project, a detailed justification of the need for the extension, a timeline for completion, and a projected completion date. The justification should be based on extenuating circumstances or unusual project requirements beyond the control of the applicant. SCEMD may grant an extension of up to 30 months. If work will extend past October 4, 2019, the FEMA Region IV Administrator is the approving authority, however, all requests will still need to be submitted through SCEMD.
