

They all hope to stay at the Trump International Hotel, Washington DC if it opens by that time frame.

I personally have been working with several other petitioners in the area of the low country in petitioners 23, 144, 152 with the historical portions of European records and domestic records in the United States of America. Guv'nor, I just wanted to inform you of this, and I hope federal recognition can be gained to acquire tribal funding, education benefits and health care from a federal source for these Native Americans of indigenous populations in the United States of America.
