Ditching, tailings, tramways, and main lines for Ashley River area phosphate mining. Main line leads to Gregg's fertilizer factory east of the project tract along the Ashley River (Site 38DR20).

Large sections converted to silviculture in mid twentieth century.

William Gregg owner (leasee) exact mining engineer unknown.

Historical Information

Historical Information:

Site is the ruins of late 19th and early 20th century phosphate mines by William Gregg (1885-1898). Gregg was one of the primary early phosphate miners in Charleston area after discovery of phosphate fields in 1860s. The mines on Watson Hill were his second effort at mining in Lowcountry. He leased Wragg's Barony and extensively mined it and bought Haggett Hall adjoining it to the north and partially mined there. In the early 20th century Charleston Mining and Manufacturing acquired the Haggett Hall tract and mined it extensively.
