To Whom It May Concern,

Earlier this year, I completed construction of a new residence at 914 Woodlawn Ave, Columbia, SC 29209. On the September 8th at 11:30AM, I called your office and spoke to a gentleman named Joel. A work order (#883973) was entered to pave a new driveway apron at the aforementioned address.

Currently there is a trench between my driveway and the street that is 6-12" deep, making it difficult for me to enter and exit the property with my vehicle and impossible for guests to enter. For this reason, I have made several follow-up calls, including those noted below on the following dates:

September 14, 2015, 10:44AM – Spoke to Joel.
September 18, 2015, 8:30AM – Spoke to Jackie.
October 16, 2015, 9:50AM – Spoke to Jackie.

I was told during those calls that the request had been accepted and SC DOT was allowed 60 days to complete the work. As of the date of this letter, the aforementioned trench remains unpaved.

As a proud South Carolinian, lifetime resident of this state and as a two-time alumnus of the University of South Carolina, I am severely disappointed that this work has not been completed before the end of 2015.

Within 30 days of the date of this letter, please provide written confirmation of the date by which the driveway apron will be paved.
