

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE UNION COUNTY COUNCIL
TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 28, 2006 AT 4:04 P.M.

Chairman Donnie Betenbaugh called the meeting to order.

Toney Farr: Made a motion to dispense with the formalities.
Dora Martin: Seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

Chairman Donnie Betenbaugh presented for second reading an ordinance authorizing a contract for the sale of land, and access agreement, and ratifying an incentive and inducement agreement between Union County, South Carolina and LSP Automotive Systems, LLC.

Toney Farr: Made a motion to accept second reading of the ordinance pertaining to LSP Automotive Systems, LLC as stated.

Dora Martin: Seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

Chairman Donnie Betenbaugh stated that approximately two years ago the Probate Judge had come to County Council concerning the need for a new microfilm reader printer and updated technology. At that time, Council had discussed taking approximately \$20,000.00 from the balance on the bond money for the jail. Mr. Betenbaugh presented a request to Council of \$43,908.00 for Probate Software and other upgrades for the Probate Judge's Office. Councilman Toney Farr asked where the funds would come from. Chairman Donnie Betenbaugh stated they could come from the balance of the Union County G. O. Bond.

Joe Lawson: Made a motion to approve the request for software and upgrades for the Probate Judge's Office.

Dora Martin: Seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

Chairman Donnie Betenbaugh stated that the rest of the funds left in the G. O. Bond may have to be used for replacement of the Bob Adams Road Bridge.

Dora Martin: Made a motion to adjourn the meeting.

Randall Hanvey: Seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:12 p.m.
