Broken Wing Riding Club

The Broken Wing Driving Club in Trenton, SC, a non-profit, all-volunteer therapeutic horse-driving organization, builds self-confidence for special needs children and adults. Participants in the program learn to groom and care for horses and handle horse-drawn carts. Broken Wing is a member of the North American Riding for the Handicapped Association and the Edgefield County Chamber of Commerce.

The club's goal is to promote the functional rehabilitation of individuals with disabilities through carriage-driving and social interaction with others. Through the program, special needs individuals have acquired a more positive physical and emotional well being for themselves. Individuals with disabilities in the program have developed confidence and feel good about what they have accomplished. Broken Wing Driving Club Strives to be consistent with these ideals in mind.

Volunteers are needed for the program to continue to be successful. Volunteers need not be able to drive in order to help, but enthusiasm and responsibility are required. Approximately 50 volunteers are needed annually for a variety of tasks including: leaders, side walkers, clerical workers and social coordinators as well as assistance in fundraising to keep the program moving forward.

Knowing that the disabled have many financial commitments, Broken Wing does not charge for any services. All disabled adults and children are trained free by an all-volunteer staff. However, Broken Wing is always in need of assistance throughout the year to purchase equipment and other items. The organization is currently in need of feed, horses or ponies that can handle wagons or carts, lumber to build a barn, posts and wire for fencing, 4 sets of gates, posts and rails to make construct a driving ring, a pick up truck, horse trailer for 2 or 4 horses, harnesses, and carts or wagons among other supplies.

Farmers and Other Landowners Apply for WRP and EQIP

The USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) recently announced that applications received by December 15, 2000, at USDA Service Centers would be considered for funding under the 2001 Wetlands Reserve Program (WRP). WRP provides technical and financial assistance in the protection, restoration and enhancement of wetlands. Approximately \$2 million is currently available for funding assistance. Applications received after the deadline will be considered for next year's program.

Landowners have the option to enroll eligible land in three categories---permanent easements (100% payment for appraised agricultural market value and 100% for restoration and maintenance), 30-year easements (75% payment for appraised agricultural market value and 75% for restoration and maintenance), or restoration only with a 10-year easement (75% of restoration with no assistance for maintenance). Over 12,000 acres in SC have been enrolled in WRP since 1996.

In addition, NRCS and the USDA Farm Service Agency (FSA) recently announced that the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) is under a continuous sign-up and applications received by December 15, 2000, at USDA Service Centers, will be prioritized for 2001 funding. EQIP provides technical and financial assistance to eligible farmers and agricultural landowners to address soil, water, and related natural resource concerns. Approximately \$1.6 million will be provided for environmental improvement in SC through 16 priority areas and a statewide conservation concern. EQIP provides cost-sharing and incentive payments for certain conservation practices such as filter strips, nutrient management, waste management systems, waste utilization, grassed waterways, prescribed grazing, vegetative buffers, and wildlife habitat enhancement. Total cost-share and incentive payments are limited annually to \$10,000 per person and \$50,000 for the life of the contract which can span five to 10 years.

Horses, Mules, and Donkeys Count

At no other time in the history of this nation has counting been as important as it recently has. As we have discovered, proper or improper counting can make the difference in success or failure.

Keeping an accurate, up-to-date count of agriculture has always been important. The history of the agricultural census dates back at least as far as President George Washington who kept meticulous records describing his own and other farms. In 1791, President Washington was asked for information by an Englishman named Arthur Young on land values, crops, yields, and livestock prices. Washington himself prepared the report, compiled the results, and sent the first "agricultural census" to Mr. Young. That was, in effect, the nation's first agricultural census.

As a major part of South Carolina agriculture, the equine industry counts. Horse owners and equine-related businessmen and women say that updated numbers and statistics would make the industry more appealing to people and businesses across the nation and, in fact, the world, and that an accurate count of horses, mules, and donkeys could lure more businesses and tourists to the state. Currently, we only have estimates about the number of equine and their economic impact.

Those estimates show that there are approximately 100,000 horses, mules, and donkeys in the state with an economical impact of \$330 million a year owned by 45,000 to 55,000 owners. The agricultural impact of the state's equine industry on our economy is also estimated to be \$1.2 billion a year. But, we really don't know if those figures accurately reflect the state's equine industry, because there has been no official, updated data or information since a survey was taken in 1979.

Horses, mules, and donkeys are livestock. They are raised, bred, fed, and sheltered just like any other member of the livestock industry. But, unlike other livestock, they are primarily used as recreation and work animals. Nevertheless, they are valuable to our economic and spiritual well being. Some say that the "outside of the horse is good for the inside of man."

Why do we need an equine census? Census data is used to prepare estimates of farm income and production costs, evaluate agricultural programs and policies, administer farm programs, and plan for operations during disease or pest emergencies. If emergency evacuation should be required for an approaching hurricane or if there should be an epidemic like the West Nile Virus that is prevalent in the northern states, we must have a complete tally of equine numbers so that we could plan preventive measures and appropriate actions. Census data is also needed to analyze and develop policies on land use, rural and urban development, and farmland assessments. Agribusinesses need census data to determine feasibility for expansion or development of equine-related businesses.

Real figures on equine inventories in the state, their value, their land use and ownership, and their economic impact are desperately needed. Additional information is needed on production expenses for our horses, mules, and donkeys, the market value of land and buildings used to house them, and the income they earn. The sole purpose of a census or survey is to secure general statistical information. Confidentiality is very important. By law, no one--neither the census takers nor any other census-taking employee--is permitted to reveal identifiable information about any person or business.

The 1790 census counted 3.9 million Americans. At that time, 9 out of 10 people lived on farms. The distinction between producers and consumers did not exist. The only concerns of the day were what crops to plant and how to ensure a bountiful harvest. Those days are long gone. Today, most of the population is far-removed from the farm. But, many continue to have some kinship to agriculture through the equine industry.

How an equine census is accomplished will depend on our state's Legislature and the equine industry, but for South Carolina agriculture to count, horses, mules, and donkeys must be counted, too.
