- (a) On August 29, 1978 at 4:05 p.m., I contacted Mr. Tom Miller of WANS Radio Station concerning the August 31, 1978 Called Meeting of Anderson County Council.
- (b) On August 29, 1978 I attempted to reach Ms. Crisby Williams and Ms. Janna Gower of the Anderson Independent and Daily Mail concerning the August 31, 1978 Called Meeting of Anderson County Council. On August 30, 1978 at 3:41 p.m., I talked with Ms. Crisby Williams concerning the matter.
- (c) On August 29, 1978 at 4:55 p.m., I contacted Mrs. Sara Liverance concerning the August 31, 1978 Called Meeting of Anderson County Council.

Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Mr. Bratcher gave the invocation.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the August 15, 1978 meeting as mailed.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Gerrard, Council voted unanimously to go into Executive Session at 9:04 a.m.

County Council met in Executive Session and received legal advise from the County Attorney, Karl L. Kenyon, concerning the Assessor's Office.

Council reconvened in public session at 9:47 a.m.

Mr. Poore stated that County Council had received legal advice from the County Attorney concerning the Assessor's Office during the Executive Session and that no action was taken.

Mr. J. Marc Hehn requested Council appropriate monies from the Contingency Fund to settle the following vehicle accidents: (a) On August 18, 1978 an uninsured Anderson County

tractor was pulling a bush-hog to Sandy Springs and hit a parked vehicle registered to Mr. Jerry Holmes. Estimated damage was \$770.50. (b) On August 24, 1978 an uninsured Anderson County truck going to Iva, South Carolina backed into a parked vehicle registered to Mr. Grady Harrison. Estimated damage was \$259.96. On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to settle these accidents and to get recommendations from the insurance company as to how accidents like these may be avoided.

On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Gerrard, Council voted unanimously to adjourn at 9:50 a.m.
