Description/Significant Features:

The single-story, side-gabled frame Period Cottage is three bays wide, clad in replacement vinyl siding, and rests on a concrete masonry block foundation. A two bay gabled porch supported by synthetic columns embraces the facade and covers the building's primary entrance, which is replacement. Replacement windows are also found throughout. An exterior shouldered chimney rises on the building's facade, just to the right of the porch.
